VISA STUDY 2026/27 – ITALY

"Enrollment"

Degree and Master degree

- **The possibility of issuing study visas will be in line with ministerial provisions and allowed until November 30, 2026 (even in the case of online classes attended).**

- PHASE 1: PRE-REGISTRATION

Before submitting the **visa application**, the student must have completed the registration and **enrollment procedure** for the course on the [UNIVERSITALY](#) Portal. Subsequently, the student will receive a notification from Universitaly summarizing **the university pre-registration application**, which must be printed in PDF format and submitted to the Embassy along with the other documents required for the visa.

ONLY AFTER COMPLETING the entire procedure outlined in this informative document can students apply for a type 'D' visa for STUDY 'university enrollment'.

If the Universitaly pre-registration is still UNDER CONDITION, you cannot apply for the Visa Study.

- PHASE 2: VISA APPLICATION - DOCUMENTATION

- **Summary of the pre-registration application** for the chosen university course generated by the [UNIVERSITALY](#) website.
- [National visa application form type D](#) filled out in capital letters and signed in every part.
- A recent **passport-sized photo** (4.0 x 3.5 cm, color photo with a white background). You can find the guidelines at this [link](#)
- **Passport** valid for at least 90 days beyond the expiration of the requested visa.
- **Photocopy of the passport page** with personal data.

- **HEALTH INSURANCE:** An insurance policy with a minimum coverage of €30,000 for urgent medical expenses, for hospitalization, and for repatriation, valid throughout the Schengen.

The following forms of coverage are accepted:

1. A consular declaration certifying the right to healthcare under an agreement between Italy and the student's country of citizenship;
2. A foreign health insurance policy, provided that the assistance covered is valid in Italy and that it does not include any limitations or exclusions regarding the official rates established for emergency hospitalisation throughout the entire period of validity of the policy;
3. A health insurance policy issued by an Italian insurance company or institution, accompanied by a declaration from the insurer specifying that the policy does not include any limitations or exclusions regarding the official rates established for emergency hospitalisation throughout the entire period of validity of the policy.

● **MEANS OF TRANSPORT:** Flight reservation or other public transport reservation. Alternatively, a photocopy of the vehicle registration document if traveling with personal means (or of parents/family members).

● **FINANCIAL MEANS:** The means of subsistence that must be demonstrated by the student are quantified at **10.179,85 euros**. These are **minimum economic requirements**, which alone do not satisfy the verification of the socio-economic situation of the visa applicant.

The availability of 10.179,85 euros must be proven through:

- **A bank certificate covering 10.179,85**

AND

- **Proof of employment, personal or from a family member (a relative within the fourth degree of kinship) + bank statement with the evidence of the last 3 salary payments**
- **In case of COMPANY OWNERS, in addition to the personal bank certificate, bring the registration of the Company, the bank statement of the company with the balance and the turnover for the past 6 months.**
- It can also be provided by foreign or Italian citizens legally residing in Italy, or supplied by Italian institutions and entities of established credit, including universities, or by local governments or by foreign institutions and entities considered reliable by the Italian diplomatic representation.

Repatriation: availability of a sum of money sufficient to ensure the student's return to Serbia (**approximately €200**), or a plane ticket reservation for the return flight.

• **AVAILABILITY OF A SUITABLE ACCOMMODATION IN ITALY:**

Example:

- **rental contract** in the name of the interested party
 - **invitation letter** from a private individual with a copy of the inviting person's identity document and their potential residence permit ([download the hospitality form](#))
 - **accommodation assignment** to the student by the University
 - **confirmation of reservation** of a hotel or residential facility for an initial minimum period of 15 days.

• **LANGUAGE:** The required language proficiency for programmes taught in Italian is at B2 level. However, for Foundation Courses, whether taught in Italian or in a foreign language, students must demonstrate proficiency in the language of instruction at a minimum B1 level. For programmes taught in English, the required level of language proficiency is also B2.

• **VISA FEE:** The fee for the visa application is **50€ (euros)** in cash to be paid at the time of submitting the application at the counter.

• **DECLARATION OF VALUE**

For the request for a declaration of value ([Click here](#)).

IF NOT REQUESTED, the student must submit a copy of their previous study degree.

- **BOOKING AN APPOINTMENT:** The visa application must be submitted in person at the Embassy by appointment, which can be reserved online on the portal [Prenot@mi](#)

- **The possibility of issuing study visas will be in line with ministerial provisions and allowed until November 30, 2026 (even in the case of online classes attended).**
- Within **8 working days** of entering Italy, students holding the visa must apply for a **residence permit for study reasons at the competent police headquarters**; the application must be submitted through a postal kit.

- All kind of documents issued by foreign authorities other than the Serbian ones MUST be **translated** in Italian, Serbian or English and **legalized/certified in the country of issue**.
